Crime in progress - call "911"**

Kathleen Bancroft, Detective George Gray, DPD Graffiti Unit, Officer Jim Dempsey, Gang Unit, Geneta Mohan, D2 Crime Analyst, Officer Doug Grove, and Officer Glenn West, left with the community to prevent crime and graffiti vandalism in your neighborhoods. A lot can be resolved when we collaborate and communicate among each other. What are we hearing and what are we seeing? If the crime is not reported, it is not tracked. Call and report the incident even if the crime has already occurred...now it is documented!

Have the CPTED test done! What is C.P.T.E.D.?

It is Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design pronounced "sep-ted"

CPTED is a way of thinking about the relationship between criminal activity and property design, a way of designing a property to be less attractive to criminals. People who use CPTED-designed areas perceive them as safe, while "would-be criminals" see them as highly risky places to commit crime.
